Patriots of the Revolution

1. Cut out the large rectangle. The top half with the names upward will be called "THE FRONT". The bottom half with the names downward will be called "THE BACK".
2. Lay the large rectangle the blank side. Use a glue stick to put glue on the 3 edges of the top rectangle the outline of each square or rectangle (you can see the lines through the paper).
3. Fold the large rectangle so the 2 the blank sides touch. Set the paper on a table and rub the paper so the glue sets the edges tight.
4. Set the paper with the side with the shapes facing up on a pieces of cardboard or a cutting mat. (I just use old cardboard) Cut out the squares and rectangles.

You are now ready to perform the effect.

1. Hold up the card with no windows. Show both sides of the card, pointing out that there are 16 names. Mention some of them and note that they all had important roles in the founding events of our country. They are often referred to as the founding Fathers and Mothers of our country.
2. Hand them the card and ask them to pick out any of the 16 names but not to speak the name or point to the name. Take the card back and show them one side of the card. Ask if the name is on that side. If they say yes lay the card down with that side facing Up. If they say no turn the card over and lay it facing DOWN.
3. Hold up any one of the cards that has open "windows" in it. Show then 1 side and ask if the name is on that side. If they say yes lay the card down with that side facing up. If they say no turn the card over and lay it down. Do not lay the cards on top of each other. It is best to have the non window to one side and the other 3 should be placed somewhat apart.
4. At this point you have 4 cards,each with the names of the person they had selected facing up. You will now pick up the cards but the way you do this is important. Quickly pick up the 3 window cards in the right hand. Pick up the non window card, holt it vertical. and slid it to the back of the stack/ At this point the person who sleeted the card see the stack in you hand with only the non window card facing them. As you do this sevel times it will get very smooth.
5. Glance at the side of the card that faces you. You will see a single square with a name showing. That name will be the person they selected. This effect can be repeated immediately.
